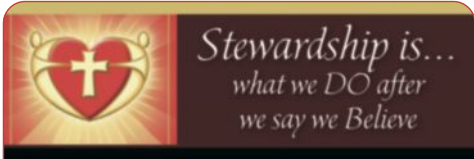

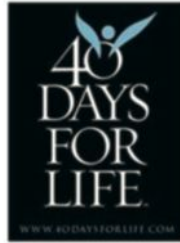

Each year our parish welcomes many adults entering the Catholic Church, or those just thinking about it, they follow a process known as the R.C.I.A. — the Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults. Today we continue sharing with you a more in depth explanation of the program.

Acceptance into the Order of Catechumens



Those who inquired into our R.C.I.A. process and who wish to continue now move onto the next stage, which is known as the Period of the Catechumenate. The Inquirers who are not already baptized will be welcomed to this next stage via the **Rite of Acceptance into the Order of**

Catechumens which will take place on October 20th at the 5:00 PM mass. As they enter this Rite they are known as Inquirers. As they leave this Rite they will now referred to as Catechumens.

This is the first rite in our R.C.I.A. process and it takes place in front of the parish community. The rite follows a simple but an important outline:

- Greeting (often with the R.C.I.A. team member or an inquirer knocking at the door of the church and asking the congregation to allow the Catechumens to enter)
- Open Dialogue where the priest presiding invites the inquirers into the church
- Affirmation by the Sponsors and the Assembly
- Signing of the Candidates with the Cross:
 - Signing of the Forehead
 - [Signing of the Other Senses] - optional
 - Concluding Prayer
- Invitation to the Celebration of the Word of God

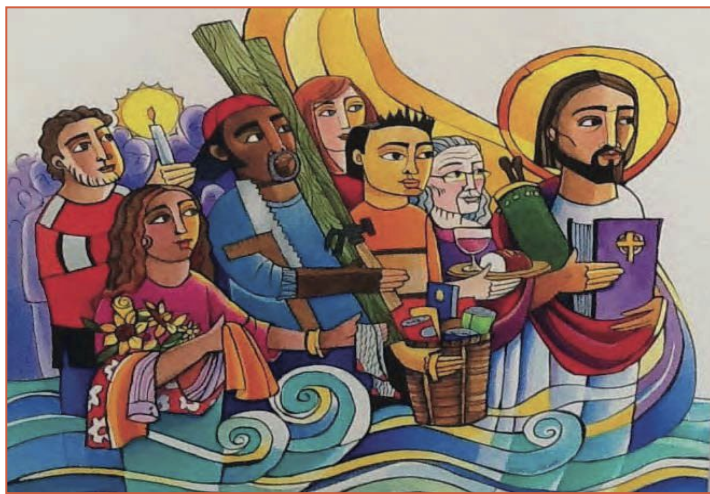
The Mass then goes on as normal with: **Liturgy of the Word**

- Readings
- Homily
- Presentation of a Bible – This is optional
- Intercessions for the Catechumens
- Prayer over the Catechumens

At this point a new portion is added

- Dismissal of the Catechumens

From this point until their baptisms, catechumens are dismissed after the liturgy of the word when they attend mass. This is to make the process feel more like it was in the early church, when Christian converts were dismissed before communion before their baptism, which often took years to prepare for, largely to build a desire for their later participation at the banquet table.

The Good News People Program

As part of the Year of Faith, the Adult Education department is offering a new program beginning in late October.

The Good News People Program is a hope-filled and enriching, small group, parish-based program inviting us to new ways of understanding our faith, ourselves, and the needs of the world around us. The program is a dynamic 14-session process (7 sessions in the Fall and 7 sessions in the Spring). Each session includes prayer, reflection on sacred scripture, teachings from the Catechism, stories of “Good News” people, discussion and sharing as well as a specific focus on a particular virtue for each week.

Participants will engage in a process designed to assist them in becoming more familiar with the biblical witness of Jesus and the call to discipleship through prayer, reflection, and action. Sign up now – and invite friends to join you. Our parish will have multiple groups of 10 people each.
