

The Period of the Catechumenate

Acceptance into the Catechumenate

In our last bulletin we discussed the four elements in the Catechumenate Period, which together are meant to bring about maturity in commitment to the

Catholic Faith. Today let's consider "Familiarity with the Christian way of Life" in relationship to our R.C.I.A. process here at St. Thomas the Apostle.

The Christian Way of Life:

Those seeking to enter the Church need to know more than just what we believe; it is important for them to see and experience what it means to live as Catholics in today's world. Through the example and the support of sponsors, godparents, RCIA team members, and the whole Christian Community, catechumens and candidates should learn the Christian way of life. By seeing what Christians do they will learn to "turn more readily to God in prayer, to bear witness to the faith, in all things to keep their hopes set on Christ, to follow supernatural inspiration in their deeds, and to practice love of neighbor."

Next week we will continue reviewing the other elements in the Catechumenate Period: Liturgical Rites and Apostolic Works.


