

## Today's Gospel Reflection

# Read Sunday's Gospel: John 21:1-19

#### **Reflection for Families:**

As parents we know a great deal about caring for sheep in the flock. We work long, hard, and diligently to make sure that our children receive the physical, emotional, and spiritual care they require. We are challenged by this Gospel reading to move outside our immediate "flock" and care for all of God's children. Our own children will learn the essence of this Gospel when they see us reconcile with others and go outside our small worlds to help others.

# Bringing the Gospel into Your Family:

Jesus invites us to follow him in the ordinary ways of our lives. An example of following Jesus can be seen in the reconciliation that transpired between Jesus and Peter. Out of paper, cut out some fish. On each paper fish invite every family member to put the name of someone they might need to reconcile with during this Easter season. You might even help one another decide on what action you will take. who might be discouraged.

#### PARISH LIFE—VIDA PARROQUIAL



This year our **Habitat for Humanity Ministry** will join the Smyrna-Cobb Habitat Coalition in building a home in West Cobb County in late August. This ecumenical effort of churches, synagogues and a mosque **will build affordable housing with a working poor family in our community.** Next weekend, April 20th-21st, ministry members will be available in the Commons Area after all masses providing information and signing-up volunteers to help us build our 19th Habitat for Humanity Home.

Our goal is to raise \$10,000 for building materials and sign up 100 volunteers. Anyone donating at least \$30 that weekend can sign a 2x4 board that will be used in building the house. Checks should be made out to "Northwest Atlanta Habitat" and can be placed in the collection basket during any Mass. We suggest a \$30 donation per family, but any gift will be greatly appreciated.
