

You Pastor's Lament

Stealing is such a sad and tragic sin... this sin is committed at banks, businesses, cars, homes and sadly, churches. Wherever there are sinners who give into this horrible temptation to steal there is injury. God sees and God knows who steals. I don't know, but God knows. If it is not yours, please do not take it PERIOD. No one has a right to steal what is not his or hers. I share this message as our parish has been hurt by stealing recently. I read an article in a liturgy magazine about people leaving valuables (phones, keys, purses, etc.) in the pew while they leave to receive Holy Communion during Mass. Some people leave their valuables in the pew so as to not give their fellow parishioner the impression that they are not trusted. That's one way of offering trust. However, my thought on it comes from the Lord's Prayer which states: "Lead us not into temptation." My suggestion is that we not leave valuables in such a way that tempt those who are thieves or potential thieves who would be better off not being tempted. May thieves repent and make restitution. That is what God awaits. Lord, hear my prayer. Fr. Brian


