

# A Stewardship Thought

Through the prophet Isaiah, God promised the Israelites "something new": their freedom from sin and exile. St. Paul reminds us that God's promises are fulfilled in Jesus.

This theme of "newness" continues in St. Mark's Gospel where the people in Christ's time are astonished by Jesus curing the paralytic, and thereby confirming His power to forgive sins. They had never seen anything like this before. We, as followers of Christ today, seek "newness" through renewal of our lives by discerning God's will. When we seek to do the Lord's work, we are moved to perform acts of charity and mercy we may not have thought possible.

# FOR FASTING AND ABSTINENCE

**Abstinence** from meats is to be observed by all Catholics 14 years old and older on Ash Wednesday and on all Fridays of Lent.

Fasting is to be observed on Ash Wednesday by all Catholics who are 18 years of age but not yet 59. Those who are bound by this may take only one full meal. Two smaller meals are permitted if necessary to maintain strength according to one's needs, but eating solid foods between meals is not permitted.

The special Paschal fast and abstinence are prescribed for Good Friday and encouraged for Holy Saturday.
