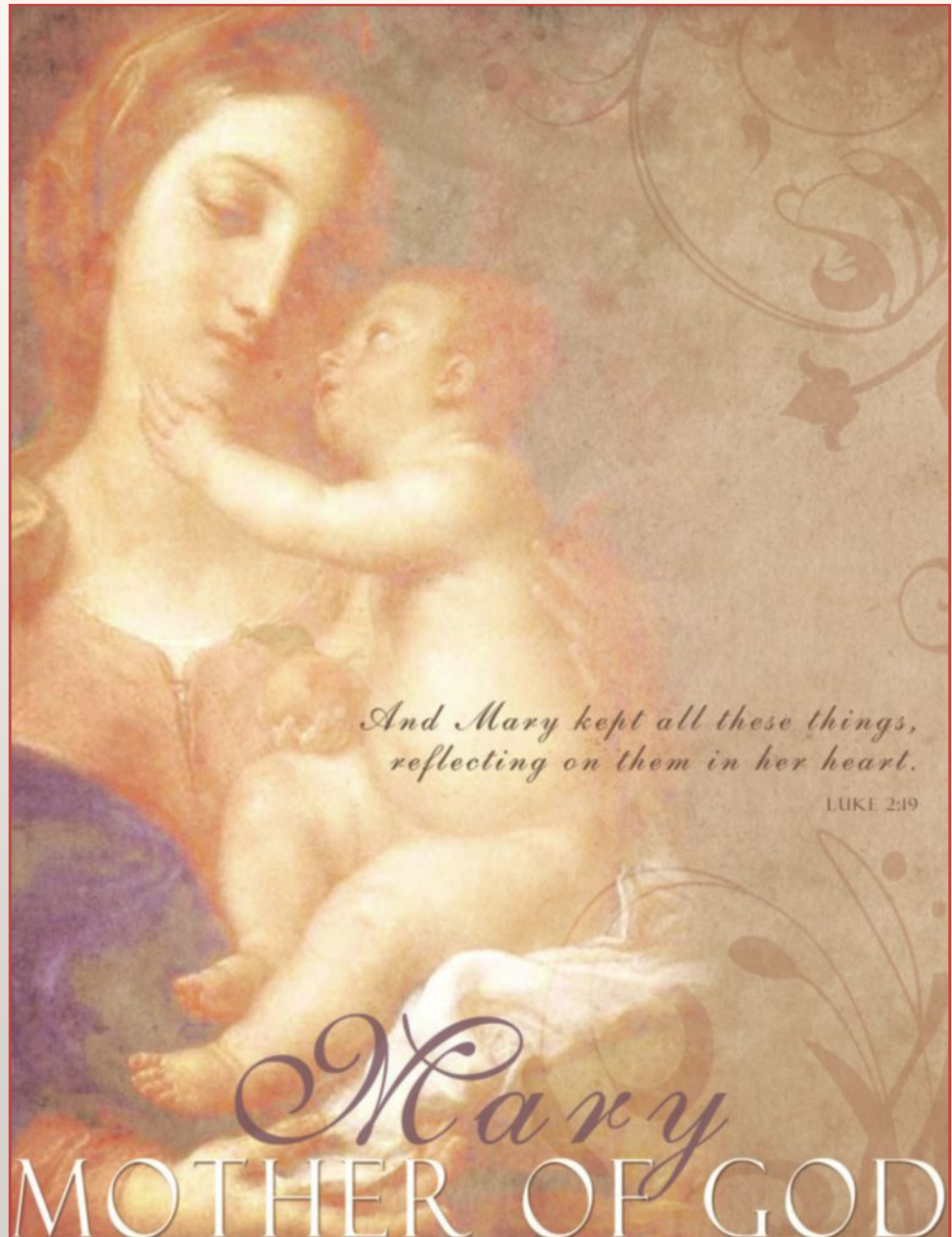

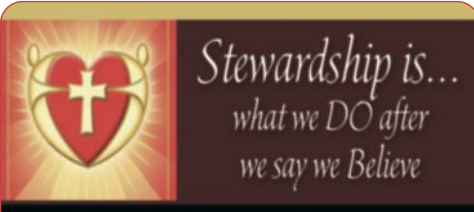

As it was announced last weekend, the Provincial Superior of the Missionaries of La Salette has named Fr. Brian R. Sheridan, M.S. as **Pastor of St. Thomas the Apostle, in Smyrna, effective January 3, 2013.**

Fr. Brian was born in East Hartford, CT in 1954. He professed First Vows as a La Salette Missionary on September 19, 1981, at Our Lady of Sorrows Church in Hartford, CT. He was ordained a Priest by Most Rev. Alfred Hughes on May 28, 1983, in Ipswich, MA.

He has served in a number of parishes, including St. Ann in Marietta, GA. Following the call to serve the foreign missions he was sent to Argentina where he served in Clodomira, Santiago del Estero. He returned to the U.S. in 1992 to become Director of the La Salette Mission Office in Hartford, CT. He served as Shrine Director in Altamont, N.Y. before becoming Pastor of Good Shepherd Parish in Orlando, FL. His most recent assignment was as Pastor at Our Lady of Sorrows, Hartford, CT.

Mary MOTHER OF GOD

Today's Gospel: Luke 16:21-26

FOCUS

"As for Mary, she treasured all of these things and pondered them in her heart."

This kind of pondering is a gift of the Holy Spirit. The many strange and difficult things that happened to Mary surrounding the birth of her Son were enough to stretch anyone's patience and limits: The announcement that she had been chosen to be the mother of the Most High God; that her conception of this child would be by the power of the Most High (these two statements together are enough to make anyone wonder); trying to explain her pregnancy to Joseph, her betrothed husband; the child's birth came when she was far from home and the support of her family; the whole cave experience was extraordinarily difficult. Indeed, it was no piece of cake for Mary to bring Jesus into the world.

However, Luke shows us that Mary went deep into her heart to find the strength and meaning of these strange happenings. In our depths, we enter a space between fascination and attraction on one side and fear and awe on the other side. Traditionally, the spiritual writers of the Church call this space the encounter with "the Holy" which means that God invades our space, with our permission, and makes the impossible for us possible.

During such experiences, which are more common than we think, all you can do is go deep and stay inside at the same time. If you try to figure out the meaning of such events or happenings, you will leave that space and the peace and strength that go with it. Simply surrender to God and His Holy Will for you. Trust and confidence in Him are paramount in times when we can't make sense of things that are happening to us.

In Jesus, the Incarnation, God has overcome our fear of the transcendence. He has bridged the gap by taking on our flesh in Mary's womb. Jesus satisfies our fascination about the invisible God by becoming visible, through Mary, His Mother. Because of our Mother's "yes to God" when she didn't fully understand, He is no longer distant and beyond our human experience.

Suggestion for Prayer and Reflection:

Mary's cooperation with God meant she had to meet Him deep inside her heart and stay there, letting him sort out all the particulars about Jesus' birth and its meaning.

- Do you need to go deep inside sometime and ponder with the Holy Spirit the events of your life?
- Can you stand not being in control, but allow the Lord the time He needs to fulfill all of His promises to you and your family?
- Perhaps a decade of the Rosary now and then, can be a great help to enter with Mary into the depths of God.

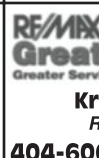
