Jamaican Outreach Ministry—A new record is set in donations received!

The Missionaries of the Poor, Fr. HoLung, your Jamaica Outreach Ministry and especially the poor people of Kingston, wish to thank the wonderful parishioners of St Thomas the Apostle church for their generous giving of food during the most recent Lenten Food Drive. Over 25,600 lbs of food were collected. **This amount is the highest we have ever collected in our twenty years of food drives.** It is being sent via ship's container and will arrive in the port of Kingston around April 15. Our children from PSR collected 100s of additional items needed such as toothbrushes, toothpaste, gauze and diapers.

On the weekend of April 20-21, **Our Habitat for Humanity Ministry** will begin this year's campaign to raise the needed funds to build our 19th house. Ministry volunteers will be available in Commons after all masses on that weekend. Anyone donating at least \$30 on that first weekend can sign a 2 x 4 board that will be incorporated into the building of the house. Checks should be made out to "Northwest Atlanta Habitat" and can be placed in the collection basket during any mass. We suggest a \$30 donation, but any gift will be greatly appreciated. Thank you!

Today's Gospel Reflection

Read Sunday's Gospel: John 20:19-31.

Reflection for Families:

Parents are often the source of hope and encouragement for their children. When a child falls repeatedly while learning to walk or ride a bike, it is a parent who coaxes, encourages, and praises the child. Parents provide hope and comfort when a child falls short of a goal whether in academics, relationships, sports, or the arts. Parents can relate to the role of Jesus with his disciples. They were frightened and discouraged but they found hope and relief with the peace and presence of Jesus.

Bringing the Gospel into Your Family:

Using the newspaper, news broadcast, or situations you know about, share ideas about people in the world or your community who might be discouraged. Suggest ways either in prayer or by action that your family might bring hope to these people.

I remember once I was really discouraged but I found peace when...

I can relate to the "doubting" Thomas, but I have learned...

Confirmation Classes: May 5th – June 30th

Who may apply? Baptized Catholic adults 18+ who do not have any other impediments to receiving the Sacraments (such as irregular marriage/need for annulment).


