If we want to know what Jesus' parable is about in today's gospel, it seems that we don't need to work too hard because Saint Luke tells us right at the beginning: "Jesus told his disciples a parable about their need to pray always and not to lose heart."

This parable has often been used to bring comfort to us about our prayer life.

But could there be a more challenging message for those who take stewardship seriously? Widows were the poorest and most vulnerable of people in Jesus' time. Oppressive legal and economic structures were the norm.

Could it be that we are also encouraged to pray persistently for the poor, the weak and the vulnerable as we hear their cry for justice?



In our St. Thomas the Apostle Parish we have a tradition of remembering all members of our community, especially those who have died during this past year since last All Souls Day of 2012.

Our All Souls Day Mass on Saturday,
November 2nd at 9:30 a.m. in the
Sanctuary invites your presence and
participation. The Clergy and Bereavement
Ministers of the Parish invite you, your
family and friends to join us. During the
Mass you will have an opportunity to go to
a microphone and offer the name of your
loved one and light a candle from the
Paschal Candle in remembrance of his or
her life. The lit candle will then be planted
in our garden of remembrance, in front of
the Altar.

A pot-luck reception will follow the Mass in the Social Hall. The parish will provide the beverages.

Gospel Reflection

Today's Gospel: Luke 18:1-8

Reflection for Families:

What happens when our children pester us long enough for something? If it's not life threatening and they've bugged us long enough, we usually find a way of giving in without losing face. We know just how the judge in Luke's Gospel felt! Let the story of the persistent widow strengthen your prayers. Even if they are not answered in just the way we ask, God hears our prayers and cares for us.

Bringing the Gospel into your Family

Be faithful praying with your children. Teach them simple prayers for starting their day, grace before meals, and prayers at bedtime. Say prayers every day. Here are some suggestions:

- A Morning Prayer: Dear God, We offer this day to you and all we think and say and do. Amen.
- A Bedtime Prayer: Angel of God, my guardian dear, to whom God's love commits me here. Ever this night be at my side, to light, to guard, to rule and to guide. Amen.




