
Our parish Mission is scheduled to be from December 15th to 17th from 6:45 p.m. to 9:00 p.m. every night.

CHILDREN'S CHRISTMAS CHOIR

What? Children's Choir to lead music at 4:00pm Christmas Eve Liturgy (English). For whom? Children in grades Kindergarten through 8 (Grade level is the determining factor, not age) When and Where Are Rehearsals? Four rehearsals (mark these dates on your calendar!):

- Monday, December 1 5:45 p.m. -6:45 p.m. in the Music Room
- Monday, December 15 5:45 p.m. -6:45 p.m. in the Music Room
- Monday, December 22 5:45 p.m. -6:45 .p.m. in the Music Room
- TUESDAY, December 23 5:45 p.m. -6:45 p.m. in the Sanctuary

Note that there is no rehearsal on Monday, December 8th, because it is a Holy Day of Obligation.

What Is Required? Participating children must:

- Attend at least three of the four rehearsals in order to participate on Christmas Eve.
- BE ON TIME for rehearsal!
- Arrive for Christmas Eve liturgy by NO LATER THAN 3:15 p.m.
- Only the first 50 children registered will be allowed to participate. YOU MUST register in advance.

NOTE: This year at 4:00 p.m. on Christmas Eve, there will be two masses celebrated simultaneously: the children's mass in the Sanctuary and a traditional mass in the Social Hall. If you (or family members or friends) want to attend the children's liturgy in the Sanctuary, you MUST arrive very early for seats. Once capacity has been reached in the Sanctuary, individuals will be directed to Mass in the Social Hall.
