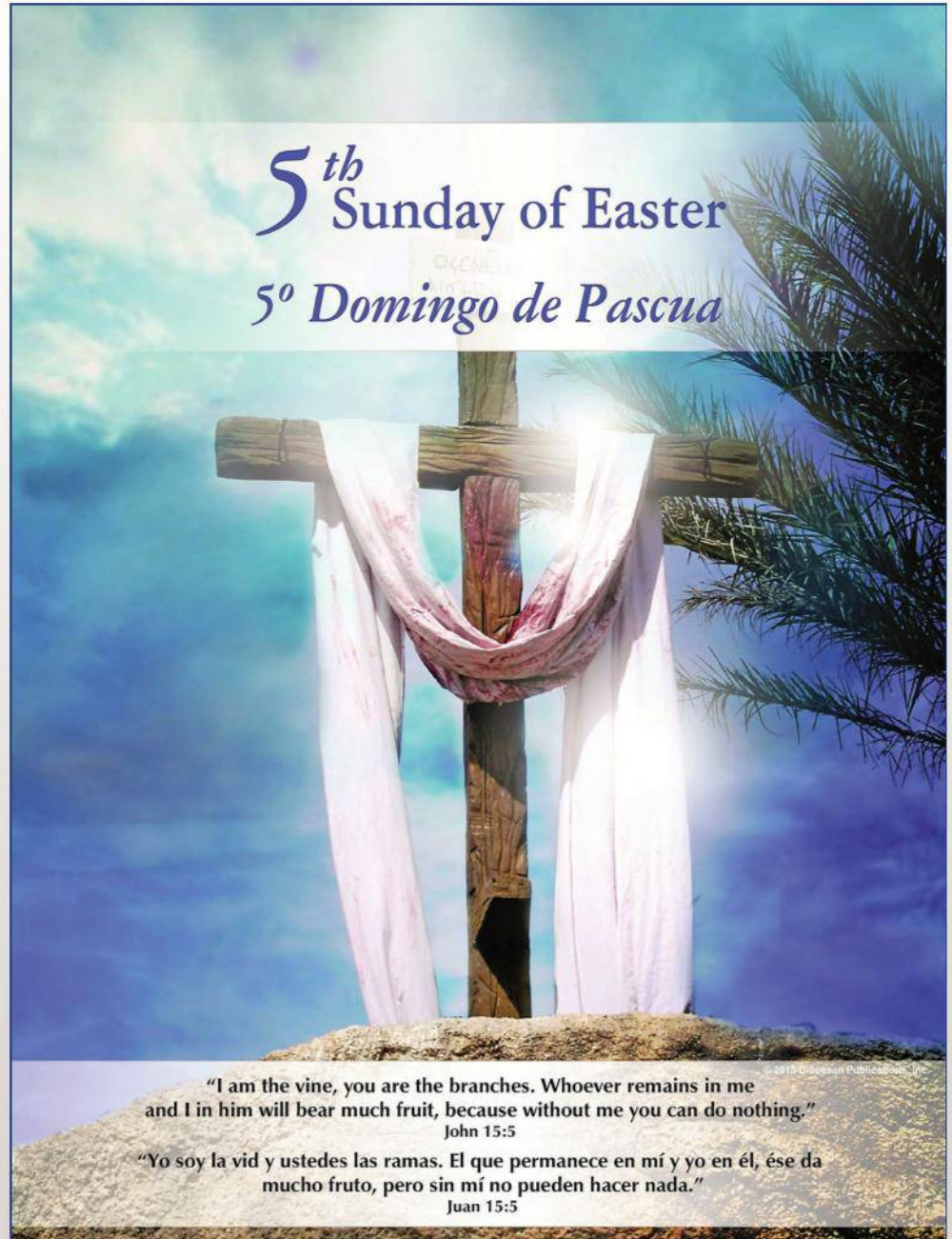

Altar and Ambo in our sanctuary

On that first Easter Day, the two disciples at Emmaus recognized the Lord at the "breaking of the Bread." That is a phrase used by St. Luke to describe the Mass. When Jesus disappeared, they remembered how their hearts were aglow when He spoke the Words of Scripture about the Messiah. They rushed back to Jerusalem and told their story. All of a sudden, Jesus was in the midst of the assembly.

So we have three dynamic dimensions that can help us understand the Mass and why our sanctuary is the way it is: the Word, the Eucharist, and the Community. Liturgical design of most modern churches addresses the first part of the Mass which is the Word. The Word's proclamation was given more prominence. God is present in His Word; so we have the table (altar) of the Word now called the Ambo, smaller but on par with the other table of the bread and wine that continues to be called the Altar.

The Lord is present in the Eucharist; and so we have the table of offering and sacrifice, called the Altar. We remember that the Lord said "This is my body." We partake of His Body and Blood and become one with Him and with one another (Community). And we become more like him.

Jesus is present in the Community as He was in Jerusalem. Just as we recognize one another, we need to recognize that He is in our midst. It was to the assembled community that the Holy Spirit came on Pentecost and those who spoke in the Spirit, spoke through the Community. We cannot underestimate the importance of the threefold dynamic dimensions of the Mass: the Word, the Eucharist and the Community it forms. Let us be one in the Lord at St. Thomas the Apostle.
